Due to General Data Protection Legislation & Safeguarding Policies,

 - Certificates of Baptism or Confirmation or Letters of Freedom for anyone over the age of 18 years must now provide proof of permission to seek and collect these documents.
 - Please contact the Priest/Parish Office for further information.
- Envelopes for 2020 for the Parishes of Roscrea,
 Bournea, Kyle & Knock: You may have already or
 will shortly receive your
 Box of Parish Envelopes for 2020.
 We are only allowed to distribute Boxes of
 Envelopes to people who have used the Box of
 Envelopes as a way to contribute to the parish
 over the last three years. If you contribute to the
 basket directly but would like to receive a Box of
 Envelopes, please contact the Parish Office.
- The Pastoral Area may only operate a "page" on Facebook to comply with this legislation – our Pastoral Area facebook page is "Parishes of Roscrea, Bournea, Kyle & Knock."
