#### **Current Restrictions**

• Public Masses are now permitted from 10<sup>th</sup> May with 50 people in attendance, however... In line with recommendations received from Bishop Fintan, where a church is bigger and can safely accommodate larger numbers, there is an increased capacity permitted attending for Mass. Therefore, we can accommodate 80 people at Mass in St. Cronan's Church Roscrea. Weddings and funerals are capped at 50 people regardless of size of premises.

- First Friday and pastoral visits suspended
- Churches remain open for private prayer 10.30am to 2pm
