#### **Re-Opening Churches**

The Pastoral Councils of Roscrea, Bournea, and Kyle & Knock have decided to postpone opening of the churches for public Masses and Sacraments until July, due to the fact that certain conditions need to be met. The Pastoral Councils are taking very seriously the health and safety of our community and until this can be guaranteed, it has been decided not to open.

With this in mind, we are looking for volunteers in two specific roles: Ushers and People willing to clean the churches after every gathering

If we cannot get a sufficient number of volunteers, we will be unable to open the church buildings for public Mass. The people we ask to volunteer must not be putting themselves in any vulnerable position so if you have an underlying health condition, please do not feel under any obligation to volunteer. ### Mary's Meals – Present for my Teacher

www.marysmeals.ie Parents/guardians can buy an online gift for their children's teachers in exchange for a donation towards the work of Mary's Meals Ireland. It's really two presents in one – a beautiful e-card that kids can safely send to their teacher by email and the promise of daily school meals for children in some of the world's poorest communities. Donations of any amount are gratefully accepted; it costs just €18.30 to feed a child for an entire school year and at least 93% of all donations are spent on charitable activities.

It's a simple idea that works. In schools where children receive Mary's Meals, enrolment goes up, fewer children skip lessons or drop out of school, students find it easier to concentrate in class and exam results improve.

At the beginning of Lent, we began to collect filled schoolbags for Marys Meals – due to Covid restrictions, this collection is still taking place. If you have any stationery or school essentials you could donate, we would be very grateful to pass them on to Marys Meals. Thank you to all who donated filled school bags up to now.
