Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

From 12 Noon on November 1st until Midnight November 2nd all who have Confessed, Received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.

This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confessions may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following November 1st.

Holy Communion may be received on any day from the 1st November to 8th November.

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1^{st-} 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
