**Communion Rite.** Here we prepare to receive the Body and Blood of Christ, by reciting the Lord's Prayer, by exchanging a sign of peace, by praying the Lamb of God. **Concluding Rites** Following a final blessing we are sent out to live our Christianity, "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord".
