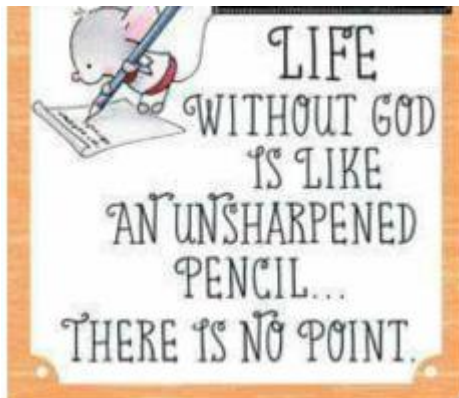
A Prayer of Hope
