In his address on Easter Monday, Pope Francis said

that faith & hope are a gift from God & we have to ask:

'Lord, give me faith, give me hope! We have so much need!'" He went on to say: "The silent witness to the events of the Passion & Resurrection of Jesus was Mary. She was standing next to the cross: She did not collapse in the face of grief, but her faith made her stronger. In the broken heart of a mother, there was always the flame of hope. We ask her to also help us to accept in fullness the Easter proclamation of resurrection, to embody it concretely in our own daily lives."
