## **Cluster Pilgrimage to the Holy Door**

**The Cronan Cluster will hold a  
Pilgrimage to the Holy Door of  
Mercy at Mount St. Joseph Abbey  
on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> September – more  
details to follow.**

Last year, in announcing the Holy Year of Mercy, which began on December 8<sup>th</sup> 2015 & will continue until November 20<sup>th</sup> this year, Pope Francis designated two Holy Doors in the Killaloe Diocese – one being at the Cathedral in Ennis & the other at Mount Saint Joseph Abbey. A holy door or porta sancta has been used since the fifteenth century as a ritual expression of conversion. Pilgrims and penitents pass through it as a gesture of leaving the past behind and crossing the threshold from sin to grace, and from darkness to light.

Pope Francis invites all of us “to open our doors to meet Jesus, who waits for us patiently & wants to bring us His blessing & friendship.”

An indulgence may be gained during the Jubilee Year by making a visit to the Holy Door, celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation, receiving Holy Communion & praying for the Pope’s Intentions.
