Migrant Sunday today Sunday 15th January

Pope Francis message builds on this theme of welcome for migrants and refugees and focuses on 'Child Migrants, the Vulnerable and the Voiceless'. Pope Francis says, "I feel compelled to draw attention to the reality of child migrants, especially the ones who are alone. In doing so I ask everyone to take care of the young, who in a threefold way are defenceless: they are children, they are foreigners, and they have no means to protect themselves. I ask everyone to help those who, for various reasons, are forced to live far from their homeland and are separated from their families."
