Today launches The World Meeting of Families 2018 in our parish.

Pope Francis has chosen Dublin to host this event, which is held every three years. It will take place the 21^{st} – 26^{th} August 2018.

The World Meeting of Families (WMOF) started in 1994, when Pope St John Paul II asked the Pontifical Council for the Family to establish an international event of prayer, catechesis & celebration that would draw participants from around the globe & that would help to strengthen the bonds between families.

The WMOF 2018 will explore the Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World & what it means for families & the Church today. It will

be a joyful & enriching occasion for adults, young people & children. During these five days, in the RDS Dublin, there will be time to meet & share, pray & reflect, grow in faith & love, celebrate, as well as gather strength to continue the journey of life.
