

# Rite of Marriage

(P: Priest; B&G: Bride & Groom)

Within the Rite of Marriage, there are various options which are outlined next. You can choose various parts within the options eg the Questions from Option 1 and the Declaration of Consent from Option 2

# **Option 1**

Priest:Now as you, Bride & Groom, are about to exchange your marriage vows the Church wishes to be assured that you appreciate the meaning of what you do, and so I ask you: Have you come here of your own free will and choice and without compulsion to marry each other?

B&G: We have.

P: Will you love and honour each other in marriage all the days of your lives?

B&G: We will.

P: Are you willing to accept with love the children God may send you, and bring them up in accordance with the law of Christ and his Church?

B&G: We are.

#### **Declaration of Consent**

- P: I invite you then to declare before God and His Church your consent to become husband and wife.

  Bride & Groom face each other and join hands.
- P: Groom, do you take Bride as your wife, for better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness and in health til death do you part?

G: I do.

P: Bride, do you take Groom as your husband, for better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness and in health til death do you part?

B: I do.

P: What God joins together, man must not separate. May the Lord confirm the consent that you have given and enrich you with His blessings.

### Blessing of the Rings

P: Lord, bless Bride & Groom and consecrate their married life.

May these rings be a symbol of their faith in each other and a reminder of their love. May they always be true to each other.

May they be one in heart and mind.

May they be united in love forever.

B&G: Amen.

G: Bride, wear this ring, as a symbol of our love and fidelity.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

B: Groom, wear this ring as a symbol of our love and fidelity.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

- G: Bride, I give you this coin, a token of all I possess.
- B: Groom, I give you this coin, a token of all I possess.
- P: Bride & Groom, in the presence of God & all here, you have made your marriage vows to each other & have declared marriage by the giving & receiving of rings.

  Therefore, in the name of God, I pronounce you Husband & Wife.

# **Option 2**

Priest:Bride & Groom, you are about to celebrate this sacrament.

Have you come here of your own free will and choice to marry each other?

B&G: We have.

P: Will you love and honour each other in marriage all the days of your lives?

B&G: We will.

P: Are you willing to accept with love the children God may send you, and bring them up in accordance with the law of Christ and his Church?

B&G: We are.

#### **Declaration of Consent**

- P: I invite you then to declare before God and His Church your consent to become husband and wife.

  Bride & Groom face each other and join hands.
- G: I, Groom, take you, Bride, as my wife, for better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness and in health all the days of our lives.
- B: I, Bride, take you, Groom, as my husband, for better or worse, for richer or poorer, in sickness and in health all the days of our lives.
- P: What God joins together, man must not separate.

  May the Lord confirm the consent that you have given and enrich you with his blessings.

### Blessing of the Rings

P: Lord, bless these rings. Grant that those who wear them may be faithful to each other. May they do Your will & live in peace with You in mutual love.

B&G: Amen.

- G: Bride, wear this ring, as a sign of our faithful love. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- B: Groom, wear this ring as a sign of our faithful love.
  In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

B&G: This gold & silver we hold together is a sign of all that we possess & share as one.

# **Option 3**

Priest:Bride & Groom, you have come to this church so that the Lord may seal your love in the presence of the priest & the community. Christ blesses this love. He has already consecrated you in Baptism; now, by this special sacrament, He strengthens you to fulfil the duties of your married life.

Have you come here of your own free will and choice to marry each other?

B&G: We have.

P: Will you love and honour each other in marriage all the days of your lives?

B&G: We will.

P: Are you willing to accept with love the children God may send you, and bring them up in accordance with the law of Christ and his Church?

B&G: We are.

#### **Declaration of Consent**

- P: I invite you then to declare before God and His Church your consent to become husband and wife.

  Bride & Groom face each other and join hands.
- G: Bride, do you consent to be my wife?
- B: I do.
- B: Groom, do you consent to be my husband?
- G: I do.
- B&G: We take each other as husband & wife And promise to love each other truly For better, for worse For richer, for poorer In sickness & in health All the days of our lives.
- P: The Lord has joined you together.
  May He fulfil His blessing in you;
  May He keep you in His love.

P: Almighty God, bless these rings, symbols of faithfulness & unbroken love.

May Bride & Groom always be true to each other.

May they be one in heart and mind.

May they be united in love forever, through Christ our Lord.

B&G: Amen.
