The 4th Sunday in the season of Easter is traditionally known as Good Shepherd Sunday. It is a day set aside in the Church to pray especially for vocations to the priesthood & religious life. During the recent Killaloe Diocesan Pilgrimage to mark the centenary of the Apparitions in Fatima, Bishop Fintan recorded a special message for Vocations Sunday, which can be watched on www.killaloediocese.ie.

Beatification of Fr John Sullivan

On Saturday 13th May, an Irishman will be elevated to the status of "Blessed" by the Catholic Church, one step short of being declared a saint. It will be the first ever such beatification ceremony on Irish soil.

The beatification of Fr. John Sullivan, will take place in the Jesuit's St. Francis Xavier Church on Gardiner Street, Dublin. Fr. John Sullivan was born in 1861 at Eccles Street, Dublin, to Protestant Edward Sullivan & Catholic Elizabeth Bailey. He was raised Protestant but converted to Catholicism at the age of 35 & was ordained a Jesuit priest 11 years later. He died in 1933. Known for his life of deep prayer & his work with the poor & afflicted, many people have testified to the healing power of his prayers. A number of miracles have been attributed to Fr. Sullivan.
