After 9 working building days the Children moved into their New Classrooms fully painted, tiled, fans for cooling and some shelving on Monday last. In 2 years now they have had 6 New Classrooms built by Irish Volunteers and the locals. With our Child Sponsorship Programme and the parents contribution the school is just thriving. We witnessed in the classes Children getting a deep, grounded and good education. Great Teachers of course whom we all need. English is compulsory like our Gaeilge! They have dreams, plans and wishes for the future like Irish Children. The hot food cooked for them daily is a very important part of the day as who can learn if they are hungry?! They do not get a menu or choice but really appreciate the food and lick the plates clean. I thank you all for your very generous support leading up to Christmas for here and for making all this happen. I sincerely thank all our Volunteers but especially the 5 hero's from Tipperary. Thanks especially to Denis Hennessy and his family, friends and donors. The group this year was blessed with so many volunteers aged between 20-30 years young. Young, energetic and giving so much of themselves and so generous with their time, commitment and hard work.
